 - ▶ LAND TENURE AND OWNERSHIP
- ▶ NOWDAYS THERE IS A SLIGHT SHIFT IN GENDER BALANCE,AN IMPROVEMENT
- ▶ MOST BURDEN IN RESOURCE UTILIZATION IS BORNE BY FEMALES ,EG FUELWOOD, FRUITS AND NTFP GATHERING

PHYSICAL

- ▶ FUNDS FOR EXTENSIVE INVENTORIES (Most data is outdated)

TIME

- ▶ VERY LITTLE TIME, RUSHED PLANNING AND PLANS
- ▶ NOT A GOVERNMENT PRIORITY

- ▶ POLITICAL INTERFEARANCE IN FOREST MATTERS
- ▶ IN TERM OF PRIORITY,FORESTRY IS AN AFTER THOUGHT
- ▶ CONFLICTS OF INTERESTS
- ▶ LIMITED CAPACITY IN A FOREST ASSESSMENT ,TECHNICAL KNOW HOW
- ▶ GOVERNMENT EXPECTATIONS IS TOO HIGH WHEN COLLABORATING WITH NGO'S, PRIVATE SECTOR

SOLUTION

- ▶ ENOUGH TIME TO PLAN
- ▶ ADEQUACY OF FUNDS FROM THE GOVERNMENT
- ▶ ENCOURAGE POLITICAL WILL FROM DECISION MAKERS
- ▶ PRIORITISING FORESTS
- ▶ CAPACITY BUILDING
- ▶ COLLABORATION BETWEEN GOVERNMENT AND NGO'S SHOULD HAVE REALISTIC BUDGET AND EXPECTATIONS
